**Job search skills for newly arrived migrants and refugees**

Seeking employment in our current economic situation is a huge challenge for anyone, and especially for newly arrived migrants and refugees. To better equip these people Christian Community Aid (CCA) is organising a free seminar to provide job search training on 15 May 2009 from 9:30am to 2:30pm at the Senior Citizen's Hall in Eastwood.

The guest speakers will include a representative from Centrelink and Salvation Army Employment Plus. They will cover ways to look for work in Australia including expectations surrounding the application process according to Australian culture. In addition more practical information will be provided such as resume writing, cover letters and interview skills.

“Many newly arrived migrants and refugees don’t even know the first steps to finding employment in Australia,” says Christine Palomo, Community Settlement Services Worker at CCA. “The seminar will set them on the right path to help them get a job.”
