Mentoring to find employment

Christian Community Aid (CCA) is starting an Employment Mentoring Program in the beginning of this year. Through the help of mentors, the program aims to support migrants and refugees of various backgrounds to find appropriate and meaningful employment in Australia.

Mentors are people in our community with different professional backgrounds and have experience securing employment in Australia. They work one-to-one to provide guidance and support to those who are unemployed. Mentors can assist in job search, resume writing, interview skills and sharing their knowledge of the Australian workplace culture.

“Seeking employment can be challenging for new migrants and refugees. Some have overseas qualifications and experience yet feel they are unable to use their skills in Australia. While others struggle as they have limited English language skills and lack of work experience”, says CCA Community Settlement Coordinator, Christine Palomo. “ The Employment Mentoring Program will enable migrants and refugees to gain skills and knowledge to help them enter the Australian job market successfully.”
