Support for people who are caring for others at home, including strategies to cope.

Grief and Loss

Grief and Loss counselling is provided in a safe and supportive environment.

About CCA

Christian Community Aid (CCA) is a multi-purpose neighbourhood centre which is governed by a community based Board. It was established by Churches in the Ryde - Eastwood - Epping areas in 1965 and this support continues today.

Our mission

Funding

Family Day Care

Care for children in the homes of registered carers who are selected and monitored by qualified staff under government regulations. Child Care Benefit is available from the federal government.

CCA Financial Counselling Service is a confidential service which aims to assist people experiencing financial difficulties. Social Welfare and Emergency Relief

People who are experiencing difficulties are provided with information and referrals to appropriate services. They are also offered material aid. Appointments necessary. This is a free service.

Migrant and Settlement Services

Migrants receive immigration information and assistance with settlement issues. This is a free service.
